William M. Faber, Jr. (Bill), 85, of Gibbon, died Monday, December 5, 2016 at CHI Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 am Friday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Shelton. Interment will be in Riverside Cemetery in Gibbon. Visitation will be from 5-7 pm Thursday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Gibbon.

Mr. Faber was born on December 3, 1931 in Juniata, Nebraska to William N. and Marcella C. (Weber) Faber. He grew up in Juniata and Gibbon, graduating from Gibbon High School in 1949.

On September 14, 1950 he entered the United States Navy, completing his basic training at Great Lakes, IL. He was then stationed at Stockton, CA, San Diego, CA and Japan. During the Korean War he served on the USS Leonard F. Mason. He was honorably discharged on July 13, 1954.

Upon his discharge from the Navy he returned to Gibbon to pursue his true passion, farming. William was united in marriage to Janet Moore on July 23, 1958 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Shelton. The couple made their

home in Gibbon where William continued to farm for over 50 years. In 1984 they opened Bill and Jan's Restaurant and Lounge, which they operated until 1992. They then opened BJ's Liquor which closed in 2002. Mrs. Faber preceded him in death on February 25, 2001.

William was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, the American Legion and a past member of the Elks Club. He enjoyed reading, playing cards and most of all farming.

He is survived by his children; Vicki Calhoun and husband John of North Platte, NE and Steve Faber of Gibbon; a grandson, CinJin Faber of Norfolk; three sisters-in-law, JoAnn Everett of Holdrege, Judy Ganser of Holdrege and Jackie Van Loh of Albuquerque, NM; nieces, Cindy Town and Pat Evans both of Albuquerque, NM; and many other nieces and nephews.

William was preceded in death by his parents, his wife and a sister, Jerene Beezy.

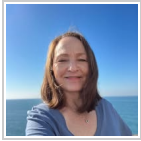
