On May 23, 1955, she married Robert J. Slocum. She later married Walt Deyle in 1976. Walt passed away in September, 1981. On February 23, 1985, Yvonne was united in marriage to Jim Barth. Jim passed away January 2, 2017.

She was a licensed insurance agent for 60+ years and she also worked as a realtor for a few years. She worked with Barney Insurance for most of the 60+ years. She served on the Professional Insurance Agents of Nebraska Board of Directors from 1987-1999. In 1990-1991, she was the first woman president

of the organization. She was Insurance Agent of the Year 1988-1989 and received various other awards. She enjoyed teaching many insurance seminars.

Yvonne was active in the Kearney Mrs. Jaycees organization and held various positions locally and state. She was active in Kearney Envoys, Kearney Women's Club, Rotary, Golden K Kiwanis, Buffalo County Chapter of American Cancer Society, Kearney Area Baseball Association Board. She also helped with fundraising for Compass House and was nominated Woman of the Year 1989-1990. She was a member of the First Lutheran Church Choir for many years. She was a member and volunteer for the Nebraska Pageant Board. Yvonne was an officer and organizer of Insurance Women of Mid-Nebraska and served as part of the selection committee for Habitat for Humanity. She was an officer and member of the Central Nebraska Auto Club Board and Crane River Theater. Yvonne was active in many other organizations and received Volunteer of the Year Award in 2013.
